2017 Residential Bulk Waste Collection Program FREE for One Week

**Collection will begin Mon. October 9 to Fri. October 13
on your regularly scheduled trash collection day.**

Please do not place any materials in the street.

Acceptable items will include: mattresses, box springs, couches, tables, toilet/sinks, carpets, lamps, vacuum cleaners and other household junk and appliances.

Unacceptable items are: tires, electronic waste (computers, televisions, phones, media players, etc.); hazardous waste (fluorescent bulbs; antifreeze, car batteries, fire extinguishers, mercury switches, motor oil /filters, propane tanks etc.); recyclables (glass bottles, plastic containers, aluminum cans, books, cardboard, etc.); organic waste (yard waste, tree stumps, grass clippings); other items (household food garbage, contractor generated construction materials, paint cans, motor vehicle parts)

Metal items are not included in this program. Please contact Borough Hall, 732-356-0833 x 635, to schedule your metal item pick up.

Refrigerators are part of this program however, the Freon must be removed by a licensed contractor and have the certification of removal affixed to the item before pickup. We are not permitted to dump these items without this certificate. Please visit New Jersey's Clean Energy Program to see how you can qualify for a \$50 rebate for recycling your refrigerator rather than discarding it.
