

Welcome to Bound Brook

Bound Brook – a historic borough of approximately 1.6 square miles and 10,400 residents – a great place to live, work and play.

First settled in the late 1600s, Bound Brook is located along the Raritan River, in the northeastern corner of Somerset County. It sits between two brooks – the Middlebrook to the west along its border with Bridgewater, and the Green Brook (also referred to as the Bound Brook) to the east along its border with Middlesex Borough and Middlesex County.

Its size is optimal — small enough to retain a “small town” flavor, and with its own downtown, but within easy travel distance of all the cultural, economic and transportation resources of the Newark/New York metropolitan area. Bound Brook is conveniently located along the Raritan Valley Line passenger railroad, which runs to Newark and New York City, as well as Interstate 287, State Highway Route 22, and Route 28 /Union Avenue.

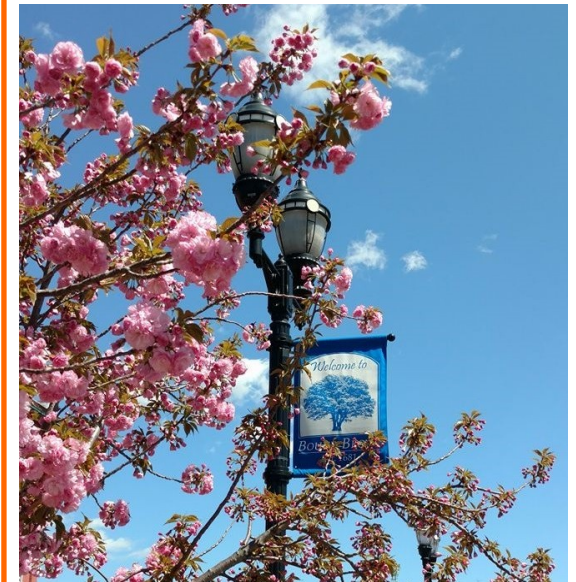

RESIDENT INFORMATION

Guidelines for Resident Trash Removal of Household Garbage

Solid Waste Collection Service

(Peter Rubinetti Private Disposal, LLC)

will collect Two (2) cans OR bags per week. Your garbage is to be placed curbside, no earlier than 6:00 PM on the evening before your scheduled pick up. Garbage pick up begins at 5:00 AM on scheduled day. **The container is not to exceed 40 gallon capacity with two handles and a lid.**

During the month of *July, August, and December*, contractor will collect Three (3) cans of household trash. If a Can is OVER the bag or can limit, it will require stickers. The sticker is to be placed in a visible location. If the garbage is placed in bags, a sticker must be affixed. Bags will not be picked up without a sticker.

FOR HOLIDAYS — If your scheduled day is on *Thanksgiving Thursday*, your trash will be picked up on *Friday*.

For *Christmas* pick up it will be the following business day after the Holiday.

RECYCLING SCHEDULE

(County Recycling – 732-469-3363)

Curbside pick up in designated blue recycling containers available at the Municipal Building.

Items Which DO NOT Require Stickers:

Brush and Yard Debris - All brush and/or yard debris must be bundled in six foot lengths or placed in garbage cans not to exceed 25 lbs. and placed at the curb for pick up on the appropriate day. Yard Debris consists of small twigs, branches with leaves attached, big weeds, etc) See list below.

Grass Clippings - must be taken to Natures Choice in Bridgewater 136 Foothill Road - 732-469-1500 Mon.-Fri.-7:30 am-3:45 pm and Sat.8 am-1:30 pm -

Leaves - are to be put in Leaf Bio-degradable Bags and placed at the curb for pick up on the appropriate day. See list below. NO PLASTIC BAGS or they will not be picked up. Leaves will be collected Mid October through Mid December and are to be placed in biodegradable paper leaf bags. After December leaves may be taken to Natures Choice in Bridgewater

Call 732-356-0833 Ext. 635 to schedule a Metal Pick Up. *Items containing Freon must have the Freon removed by a licensed contractor and have the certification of removal affixed to the item before scheduling pickup. We are not permitted to dump these items without this certificate. For Freon Removal - call Paul Spinello - 908-753-5520.
