ORDINANCE No. 2015-25

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER XXVIII, WATER AND SEWER, OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF BOUND BROOK

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bound Brook, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 28-3.5, "Flow Measurement," of Chapter XXVIII, Water and Sewer, is hereby amended and supplemented by deleting the text [**marked in bold and enclosed in brackets**] and inserting the text **underlined and marked in bold**, to read as follows:

28-3.5 Flow Measurement.

c. If a user obtains its water supply from a private well or an unmetered public water supply or utilizes a process that would yield waste water in amounts greater than the metered water use, then the owner [shall] may install a meter [**at its own cost**], the type and location of which is to be approved by the Borough prior to installation. The Borough shall provide a credit on a subsequent sewer user bill covering the cost of the installed approved meter. In the event that the user [fails] opts not to install such a meter within thirty (30) days after receiving notice from the Borough of the option to have a meter installed, then the user shall pay a charge based upon the Borough's estimate of water consumption, which estimate shall be conclusive and binding upon the user.

d. [No change.]

SECTION 2. If any article, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance and they shall remain in full force and effect, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared severable.

SECTION 3. Repealer.


All other ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed, to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency. In the event of any inconsistencies between the provisions of this Ordinance and any prior ordinance of the Borough, the provisions hereof shall

be determined to govern. All other parts, portions and provisions of the Ordinances of the Borough are hereby ratified and confirmed, except where inconsistent with the terms hereof.

SECTION 4. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect, following adoption and publication in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
