ORDINANCE - NO. 2015:27
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING
CHAPTER VII, "TRAFFIC," OF THE REVISED GENERAL
ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF BOUND BROOK
TO ADD HANDICAPPED PARKING

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Borough of Bound Brook, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, that Chapter VII, Traffic, of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Bound Brook is amended and supplemented as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 7-39.1, "Handicapped Parking on Streets," is hereby amended and supplemented by deleting the text [marked in bold and enclosed in brackets] and inserting the text underlined and marked in bold, to read as follows:

7-39.1 Handicapped Parking on Streets.

In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-197, the following on street locations are designated as handicapped parking spaces. Such spaces are for use by persons who have been issued special identification cards or plates or placards by the Motor Vehicle Commission, or a temporary placard issued by the Chief of Police. No other person shall be permitted to park these spaces.

East Second Street	South	Beginning at a point 30 feet east of the easterly curblineline of Mountain Avenue and extending to a point 8 feet east thereof
<u>East Second Street</u>	<u>South</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 36 feet west of Maiden Lane and extending to a point 52 feet west of Maiden Lane</u>
Mountain Avenue	West	Beginning at a point 26 feet, 8 inches west of the southeastern curblineline of Mountain Avenue and Somerset Street, then 38 feet south and extending 22 feet south

SECTION 2. Section 7-39.2, "Handicapped Parking on Streets for Private Residences," is hereby amended and supplemented by deleting the text [marked in bold and enclosed in brackets] and inserting the text underlined and marked in bold, to read as follows:

7-39.2 Handicapped Parking on Streets for Private Residences.

In accordance with the provisions of 39:4-197.6 **and 39:4-197.7**, the following on-street locations are designated as handicapped parking spaces in front of private residences occupied by handicapped persons. Such spaces are for use by persons who have been issued special identification cards or plates or placards by the Motor Vehicle Commission, or a temporary placard issued by the Chief of Police. No **[other]** person, **other than the permit-holder of the permit identified below**, shall be permitted in these spaces.

<i>Street</i>	<i>Permit Number</i>	<i>Location</i>
North Street West	HM8687	Beginning at a point 209 feet of the protracted southwestern curblines of West Second Street and North Street ending 308 feet south of the same curblines
<u>John Street East</u>		<u>Beginning at a point 166 feet south of the protracted southeastern curb line of East Second Street and ending 182 feet south of same curb line.</u>

SECTION 3. Section 7-39.3, "Handicapped parking in Municipal Parking Lots and Board of Education Property," is hereby amended and supplemented by deleting the text **[marked in bold and enclosed in brackets]** and inserting the text **underlined and marked in bold**, to read as follows:

7-39.3 Handicapped Parking in Municipal Parking Lots and Board of Education Property.

In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-1 and 39:4-197, the following off-street parking yards and Board of Education property are designated as Handicapped Parking areas. Such spaces are for use by persons who have been issued special identification cards, plates or placards issued by the Motor Vehicle Commission, or a temporary placard issued by the Chief of Police. No other person shall be permitted to park in these spaces.

<u>Municipal Parking Lot#2</u>	<u>1 Space</u>	<u>The first space to the East, facing south, located to the rear and between 212 East Main St. Block 1 Lot 49 and 204 East Main St. Block 1 Lot 46</u>

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SECTION 4. Severability Clause.

If any article, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance and they shall remain in full force and effect, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared severable.

SECTION 5. Repealer.


All other ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency. In the event of any inconsistencies between the provisions of this Ordinance and any prior ordinance of the Borough, the provisions hereof shall be determined to govern. All other parts, portions and provisions of the Ordinances of the Borough are hereby ratified and confirmed, except where inconsistent with the terms hereof.

SECTION 6. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect following adoption and publication in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
