Borough of Bound Brook

TO ALL RESIDENTS AND PERSONS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF BOUND BROOK, COUNTY OF SOMERSET, NEW JERSEY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the powers vested by (Chapter 251 of the laws of 1942, as amended and supplemented, N.J.S.A. App. A:9-30 et seq.; N.J.S.A. 40:48-1(6); N.J.S.A. 2C:33-1 et seq, whichever law or laws apply, a local disaster emergency is declared to exist within the boundaries of the Borough of Bound Brook.

WHEREAS, the aforesaid laws authorize the promulgation of such orders, rules, and regulations as are necessary to meet the various problems which have or may occur due to such emergency, and

WHEREAS, by reason of the rapidly evolving outbreak of the novel Coronavirus, COVID-19, the need for government operations to address the potential spread of COVID which may further adversely affect the health, safety, and welfare of the people of the Borough of Bound Brook and exacerbate and worsen existing conditions; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that these areas in the Borough of Bound Brook should be declared disaster areas and further that certain measures must be taken in order to ensure that the authorities will be unhampered in their efforts to maintain law and order, and

WHEREAS, all lands with the boundaries of the Borough of Bound Brook are hereby designated as disaster areas:

THEREFORE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH the aforesaid laws, it is promulgated and declared that the following regulations shall be in addition to all other laws of the State of New Jersey the County of Somerset and the Borough of Bound Brook,

- 1. All venues located within the Borough of Bound Brook that are licensed to sell liquor are required to close by 10:00 PM each day until further notice
- 2. All venues located within the Borough of Bound Brook that are licensed to sell liquor are required to reduce maximum occupancy by 50% each day until further notice
