#### 29-4 - DISPOSAL OF YARD WASTE

#### 29-4.1 Definitions.

As used in this section:

Containerized shall mean the placement of yard waste in a trash can, bucket, bag or other vessel, such as to prevent the yard waste from spilling or blowing out into the street and coming into contact with stormwater.

Person shall mean any individual, corporation, company, partnership, firm, association, or political subdivision of this State subject to municipal jurisdiction.

Street shall mean any street, avenue, boulevard, road, parkway, viaduct, drive, or other way, which is an existing State, County, or municipal roadway, and includes the land between the street lines, whether improved or unimproved, and may comprise pavement, shoulders, gutters, curbs, sidewalks, parking areas, and other areas within the street lines.

Yard Waste shall mean leaves and grass clippings.

### 29-4.2 Prohibited Conduct.

The owner or occupant of any property, or any agent, employee, or contractor of such owner or occupant engaged to provide lawn care or landscaping services, shall not sweep, rake, blow, or otherwise place yard waste, unless the yard waste is containerized, in the street. Provided, however, sweeping, raking, blowing or otherwise placing yard waste that is not containerized at the curb or along the street shall be allowed during the seven (7) days prior to a scheduled and announced collection for the specific type of yard waste so placed, and such yard waste shall not be placed closer than ten (10') feet from any storm drain inlet. Placement of yard waste at the curb or along the street other than in conformity with the provisions herein is a violation of this section. If non-conforming placement of yard waste occurs, the party responsible for placement of the yard waste must remove the yard waste from the street or said party shall be deemed in violation of this section. ## 29-4.3 Enforcement.

This section shall be enforced by the Police Department and the Code Enforcement Office of the Borough of Bound Brook. (Ord. No. 05-12 § 4)

# 29-4.4 Penalty.

Any person who violates any provision of this section shall be liable, upon conviction, to the penalty stated in Chapter I, Section 1-5. (Ord. No. 05-12; New)
