ORDINANCE 2017-23

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER VII, TRAFFIC, OF THE GENERAL REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF BOUND BROOK TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL PROHIBITED PARKING AREAS ON CERTAIN STREETS

WHEREAS, among other things, N.J.S.A. 39:4-197 authorizes the governing body of any municipality to adopt ordinances regulating the parking of vehicles on streets and portions thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bound Brook received a recommendation from the Bound Brook Police Department to prohibit parking in certain areas in order to promote the safety of Bound Brook’s residents,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bound Brook, in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter VII of the General Revised Ordinances of the Borough of Bound Brook, entitled TRAFFIC, Section 7-14, “Parking Prohibited At All Times on Certain Streets,” is hereby amended and supplemented by deleting the text **[marked in bold and enclosed in brackets]** and inserting the text **underlined and marked in bold**, to read as follows:

7-14 PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS.

No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any streets or parts thereof described.

SECTION 2. Severability Clause. If any article, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance and they shall remain in full force and effect, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared severable.

SECTION 3. Repealer. All other ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with this ordinances are hereby replaced, to the extent f such conflict or inconsistency. In the event of any inconsistencies between the provisions of this Ordinance and any prior ordinance of the Borough, the provisions hereof shall be determined to govern. All other parts, portions and provisions of the Ordinances of the Borough are hereby ratified and confirmed, except where inconsistent with the terms hereof.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law.
