ORDINANCE NO. 2018-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ADMINISTRATION, SECTION 2-37, CULTURAL ARTS COMMITTEE OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF BOUND BROOK.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bound Brook, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, being the governing body thereof, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2-37, "Cultural Arts Committee," of Chapter II, "Administration", of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Bound Brook is hereby amended and supplemented by deleting the text **[marked in bold and enclosed in brackets]** and inserting the text **underlined and marked in bold**, to read as follows:

2-37.3 Committee structure.

A. The Committee will be made up of a Steering Committee and various sub-committees as named and designated by the Steering Committee.

B. The Steering Committee shall consist of up to eleven **{11} 13** members. The membership makeup of the Committee and the Sub-Committees shall be determined by the by-laws.

C. The Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson, Secretary and Treasurer of the Steering Committee will be selected from one of its members in a process outlined in the by-laws.

D. Members missing more than 3 meetings will be requested to step down.

{E. The Mayor may appoint two (2) alternate members who shall have the right to attend all meetings of the Commission and to participate in discussions of any proceedings. Such alternate members shall serve for a term of one (1) year or until the appointment and qualification of a successor. The alternate members shall be designated as First Alternate and Second Alternate and in such order may vote in the event of the absence or disability of one or both of the regular representatives. No alternate member shall automatically succeed to a regular representative position upon a vacancy occurring in a regular position.}

SECTION 2. Severability Clause.

If any article, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of the Ordinance and they shall remain in full force and effect, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared severable.

SECTION 3. Repealer.

All other ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency. In the event of any inconsistencies between the provisions of this Ordinance and any other prior ordinance of the Borough, the provisions hereof shall be determined to govern.

All other parts, portions and provisions of Borough Ordinance No. 2017-29 are hereby ratified and confirmed, except where inconsistent with the terms hereof.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect following adoption and publication in accordance with law.
