Councilman distributed the August report. He noted that the tree trimming service was heavy for the month. He recognized public works foreman Vinnie Orofino being present and he is doing a very good job in the department. He thanked the department for all their help with the Riverfest Event.

Economic Development- C. Beverly Pranzatelli

Councilwoman reported that the Riverfest Street Fair was well attended. Kerry Miller asked that she present the street fair program and point out the number of organizations that participated. She advised that we had to turn away participants because we did not have enough spots. Next year we hope to have a larger fair so everyone can participate. Zoning, Construction & Code Enforcement- C. John Paul Levin Councilman thanked the EDAC for doing a good job with the Riverfest event. He read his monthly report into the record of minutes. He stated that he would like to offer comments and have them put on record. I believe the borough should put a stop to all negativity that is going around from the borough. There are rumors that certain councilmember's are putting a lot of negativity on the code and maintenance department. He commended the department for doing a good job along with the police and public works working together.

He would like to put on record to date that 82 violations were issued in the amount of \$37,200. In comparison, September 2013 there was a total of 114 inspections and so far this September 2014 there were 229 inspections. The department is working real hard making sure the town is cleaned up and following up with public works and the police department. He thought this would be a nice idea since we just had the President of Costa Rica visit Bound Brook in our celebration of Costa Rican Independence Day.
