DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

FIELD USE DISCUSSION:

Questions as to why the Tea Street fields are not being leased. Revenue has been lost because there were no permits issued for use of the Tea Street Field. When will the permits be available?

Tea Street Fields will not being leased until the borough attorney and borough administrator review the Little League Lease. The lease is still in place with little league.

Do not rent little league field during their season except for Sundays. We would need to hire someone to maintain the field after they have been rented to an outside organization.

The patio pavers were redone by the park maintenance staff.

There are ground bees in the field at Codrington. The exterminator will be in next week.

Somerville Skate park is being demolished.

TEA STREET COMPLEX: We have enough left over stone from a project at Codrington to fix up the batting cages. Reached out to Mike Witt, head of Little League, to supply details necessary to complete.

BILLION PARK: Governor Christie will be at the park for the ceremony for the flood control project.

COMMITTEES:

FINANCE/POLICY: Dave presented finance report.

PROGRAMS: Soccer is going to start next week. There are 13 teams and 2 fields for practice.

POOL/PERSONNEL: Big pool chlorinator was changed at a cost of \$500. The battery on the lift needed to be replaced at a cost of \$300.

Pool filter for large pool. If a larger filter system is installed, a larger building will be needed.

FACILITIES: Grant for soccer field was awarded.

OLD BUSINESS: Grant was received for Bache Ball Court. The courts will be installed September 27th and a ribbon cutting will take place on the 28th.
