Chair's Report:

- Received OK from state for 100 trees from NJ Tree Recovery Campaign.
- Ordered and received pencils neon colors- personalized with 'Bound Brook Tree City USA
- Nick Polanin, RCE Somerset Agriculture Agent, said he 'might' do pruning talk. Mary to follow up to get confirmation.
- Reviewed open inspection requests and did visual inspection to see if completed. Nancy Lepionka responded. Work is in progress.
- CSIP attended March 8 council meeting where presented information about CSIP grant.

 Council will decide if they are willing to put up the money. Expect answer at next council meeting. Mary talked to State Forestry Service for clarification on aspects of the application. !0 percent of the grant is held back for two years to hold the tree vendors accountable.
- Xue and Mary pruned TD Charitable Foundation grant trees on Tea Street
- Letter to Board of Ed re Community School and planning board exemption trees no response yet
- Article in Bound Brook Chronicle on Winter King Hawthorne. Next article will be Prairifire Crabapple. These are provided as part of the Shade Tree Commission's Community Outreach initiative.
- Sent tree type and address mappings for 2015 plantings to Nancy Campbell to update inventory.
- Nancy Campbell and Mary met with 3 PSE&G reps, mayor and Vince Orofino re tree pruning or removal. PSE&G identified 7 Non mature trees that they wanted to prune or remove. New state power line clearance laws are in effect as of January 2016. They can cut 10 feet above and 10 feet below wires and 8 ft on either side of power line. PSE&G put hang tags on doors to inform residents that trees were being pruned. Continuing Education: Common tree identifiers- Mary shared information about tree identification. Most trees are alternate leaves Only 4 common trees have opposite branching. Maple Ash and Dogwood and Horse Chestnut.
