

5-31 - FEEDING OF WILDLIFE ON PUBLIC PROPERTY PROHIBITED

5-31.1 Definitions.

As used in this section:

Feed shall mean to give, place, expose, deposit, distribute or scatter any edible material with the intention of feeding, attracting or enticing wildlife. Feeding does not include baiting in the legal taking of fish and/or game.

Person shall mean any individual, corporation, company, partnership, firm, association, or political subdivision of this State subject to municipal jurisdiction.

Wildlife shall mean all animals that are neither human nor domesticated.

5-31.2 Prohibited Conduct.

No person shall feed, in any public park or on any other property owned or operated by the Borough of Bound Brook, any wildlife, excluding confined wildlife (for example, wildlife confined in zoos, parks or rehabilitation centers, or unconfined wildlife at environmental education centers). (Ord. No. 05-11 § 3)

5-31.3 Enforcement.

This section shall be enforced by the Police Department, the Code Enforcement Office and the Department of Health of the Borough of Bound Brook. (Ord. No. 05-11 § 4; Ord. No. 05-14 § 1)

5-31.4 Penalty.

Any person who violates any provision of this section shall be liable, upon conviction, to the penalty stated in Chapter I, Section 1-5. (Ord. No. 05-11 § 8; New)
