RESOLUTION APPROVING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION TO 507 EAST MAIN STREET URBAN RENEWAL, L FOR PROPERTY KNOWN AS 507 WEST MAIN STREET, BLOCK 13.03, LOTS 1 AND 12.01 AND BLOCK 13, LOT 10.01 LOCATED IN REDEVELOPMENT AREA 1

WHEREAS, property commonly known and identified as 507 East Main Street and designated as Block 13.03, Lots 1 and 12.01 and Block 13, Lot 10.01 on the official tax map of the Borough of Bound Brook (the "Property"), is located within the Downtown Redevelopment Area (the "Redevelopment Area") in the Borough of Bound Brook; and

WHEREAS, the Property is subject to the Redevelopment Plan for the Redevelopment Area, as amended (the "Redevelopment Plan") and

WHEREAS, the Property is presently owned by 507 East Main Street Urban Renewal, and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Bound Brook (the "Borough") previously entered into a redevelopment agreement with the Redeveloper dated November 7, 2017 (the "Redevelopment Agreement") for the redevelopment of the Property (the "Project; and

WHEREAS, the Redeveloper has achieved Substantial Completion of the Project under the terms of the Redevelopment Agreement to the satisfaction of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, based upon the Substantial Completion of the Project under the terms of the Redevelopment Agreement, the Redeveloper has requested that the Borough execute and deliver a Certificate of Completion pursuant to and consistent with the terms of the Redevelopment Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bound Brook that it hereby approves and directs the Mayor to execute and deliver to the Redeveloper a Certificate of Completion for the Project pursuant to and consistent with the terms of the Redevelopment Agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Borough Clerk are hereby directed to execute any and all documents necessary or convenient to the transaction(s) contemplated and authorized, subject to final review and approval by the Borough Attorney.

RESOLUTION 2024-172

RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT TO COMMUNITY GRANTS, PLANNING AND HOUSING FOR HOUSING REHABILITATION ADMINISTRATION

WHEREAS, the Borough of Bound Brook requires Housing Rehabilitation Program Administration Services; and

WHEREAS, the Borough wishes to retain the services of CGP&H, LLC ("CGP&H") to perform such affordable housing administrative services in accordance with its proposal, attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, CGP&H possesses the requisite expertise and skilled personnel required to provide affordable housing administrative services to the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough are desirous of awarding a contract for affordable housing advisory services to CGP&H in accordance with the procedures mandated under the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq. requires that the resolution awarding contracts for services without competitive bidding and the agreement between the parties must be available for public inspection; and

WHEREAS, the affordable housing advisory services are for an amount not to exceed \$40,000, which below the public bid threshold under the Local Public Contracts Law, <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:11-1 et <u>seq.</u>; but exceeds the "pay to play" threshold \$17,500 under the New Jersey Local Unit Pay-To-Play Law, <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 19:44A-20.4 <u>et seq.</u>; and

WHEREAS, proposed cost of services to be provided for the affordable housing consultation services is set forth in CGP&H's accompanying proposal which is available for public review in the Borough Clerk's office; and

WHEREAS, copies of the Political Disclosure Form, Business Entity Disclosure Statement and Business Registration Certificate for CGP&H - revealing that CGP&H has not made any reportable political contributions - have been filed with the Borough Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the award of a contract for the performance of affordable housing administrative services is in the best interests of the Borough and the implementation of this contract is necessary for the efficient operation of the Borough;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bound Brook, in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1. That CGP&H shall be and is hereby appointed to perform professional affordable housing administrative services on an as needed basis to the Borough, in accordance with its proposal, attached hereto and made a part hereof, for an amount not to exceed \$40,000.
- 2. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to execute a contract with CGP&H for the provision of affordable housing advisory services to the Borough.
- 3. That CGP&H is specifically placed on notice that it will be required to comply with the Affirmative Action regulations of P.L. 1975 c. 127.
- 4. That a notice of the contract award shall be published, and this resolution must be available for public inspection, in accordance with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.
- 5. That the Chief Financial Officer shall certify as to the availability of funds for this purpose in account #11- 9999- 0000- 0000- 2-01000.
 - 6. That no further action of the Borough shall be required.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN ADDENDUM TO THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT WITH THE SUPERIOR OFFICERS ASSOCIATION OF NEW JERSEY STATE POLICEMAN'S BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION BOUND BROOK LOCAL #380 FOR THE PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 2024, THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2028

WHEREAS, the Borough of Bound Brook ("hereinafter referred to as "the Borough") and the Superior Officers Association of New Jersey State Policeman's Benevolent Association Bound Brook Local #380 ("hereinafter referred to as "SOA") entered into a collective bargaining agreement November 9, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the governing body desires to make and an addendum to the collective bargaining to bring the SOA Collective Bargaining Agreement into alignment with the PBA Patrolmans Collective Bargaining Agreement; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bound Brook authorize amending the SOA Collective Bargaining Agreement as follows:

1. ARTICLE XXVI HEALTH BENEFITS CO-PAYMENT

A. Health Benefit Premium Co-Payments: Officers shall contribute the requisite amount required by P.L. 2011, c. 78 (commonly referred to as "Chapter 78") to the cost of medical benefits. The dental plan payment limitations set forth in the prior section shall remain.

2. ARTICLE XVI RETIREMENT BENEFITS

Section 1.

Effective January 1, 2024, upon retirement and 25 (twenty-five) years in the Police and Firemen's Retirement System or retiring under Police and Firemen's Retirement System disability retirement, the member's medical-surgical premiums that were maintained while employed shall continue to be paid in full by the Borough.

3. ARTICLE VII BASE SALARY, WAGES AND LONGEVITY

Section II:

Salaries for members of the SOA shall be adjusted as follows:

- i. 2024 Salary Increase of \$6,000 for Captain and Lieutenant
- ii. Annual salary increases for years 2025 through 2028 shall be amended as follows:

2025 - 2.75%

2026 - 2.75%

2027 - 2.75%
