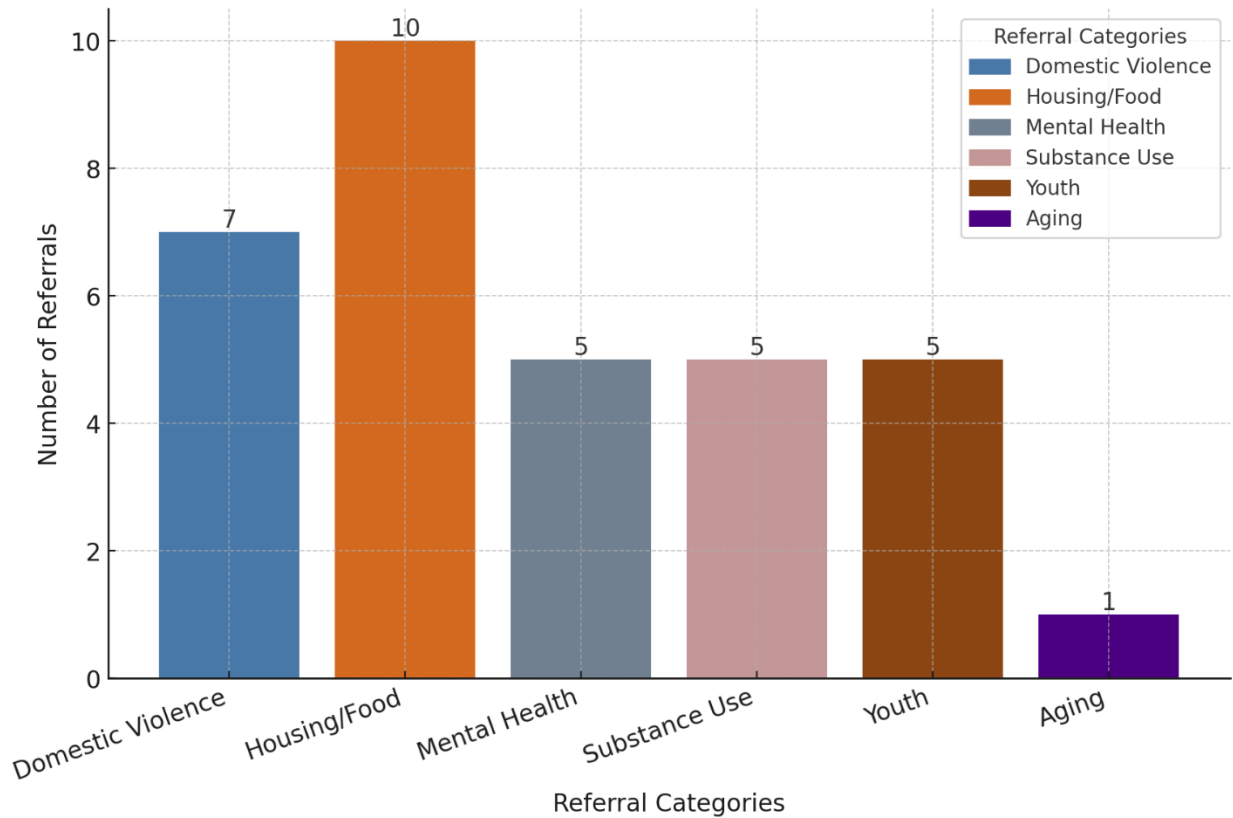




The total number of referrals received for the month of February 2025 was 33, with 15 referrals coming directly from BBPD and 18 from community sources. The breakdown of referral categories is as follows:

1. Domestic violence: 7
2. Housing/food: 10
3. Mental health: 5
4. Substance use: 5
5. Youth: 5
6. Aging: 1
